### About Pamirian Foundation

Pamirian Foundation was founded during the COVID-19 pandemic through passion and dire need to reach out and empower widows and orphans in African rural communities.





## Our History

Chinwe Enyinna, a practicing professional Nurse in Nigeria and the UK, global health advocate and champion for women and children's wellbeing had the desire to establish a foundation as a channel to give back to her community and society but didn't know how to go about it. During the 6 months' lockdown in Nigeria as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, she met someone; Chibuike Maduike who shared similar values and passion. They both believed that giving widows and orphans the opportunity to take charge of their lives through empowerment will contribute to eradication of poverty, break the cycle of total dependency, empower them to live a more fulfilling life, and foster social equality.

Today, Pamirian Foundation (PAF) has implemented community intervention programs including free feeding projects, and capacity building trainings impacting about 150 widows and orphans in African rural communities in totality through collaborative partnership, donations and sponsorships.

### Core Programme Areas.

Pamirian Foundation is all about creating a safe and a better world for vulnerable widows and orphans as such, we implement interventions in the following areas;

### Micro Loan Support:

We empower widows with noninterest micro loan to enable business scale up.

### Educational Support:

We provide educational support including reenrolment and school bag packs to both out of school orphans and enrolment of those who has never been enrolled in school.

### Skill<u>s</u> Acquisition Training:

We engage adolescent orphans in vocational skills and provide start-up materials to enable them achieve economic resilience and also reduce inequalities in African rural communities.

### Free Feeding **Programs**:

We provide free feeding programs to help address the issue of hunger in rural communities.



## <u>Target Beneficiaries</u>

### Vulnerable widows between the ages of 23 years - 45 years old

Our reason for the age range is because vulnerable widows within 23 years – 45 years of age are always victims of discrimination, denied right to property ownership, emotional and mental abuse, threat to life, poverty and lack of source of income. This problem and more can be very suicidal and dangerous hence the level of our intervention programs

### Vulnerable Orphans between the ages of 0 - 18years old.

While orphans between the ages of O – 18years suffer from malnutrition and become victims of violence, peer pressure, kidnap, sexual and emotional abuse, crime, early child marriage, STDs etc.

Our levels of intervention seek to close the gap losing a loved one can create especially in situations where the victims are very vulnerable without support, hope or any legitimate means or source of survival.



# <u>Programme</u> Implementation, 2021.

Pamirian Foundation conducted an outreach at Umuigwe Obokwu Ezinihitte Mbaise Imo State, Nigeria sponsored by Ikenna Ebegbulem.

The outreach held on 6th June, 2021, with the aim of feeding 50 widows and orphans, and delivering a lecture on social development with a focus on combating anti-social cultural behaviour. This event was part of our ongoing efforts to support vulnerable community members and promote positive societal values.

The Objectives of the projects were;

- To reduce hunger among 50 widows through a free feeding project.
- To raise awareness about anti-social cultural behaviour and its negative impacts.
- To promote social development through education and community engagement.





## Planning and Coordination

A dedicated team was formed to oversee the planning and execution of the event. This included coordinators, volunteers, and speakers. Around 90 percent of the project was funded by Mr. Ikenna Ebegbulem.

Pamirian Foundation Team Collaborated with local community leaders which helped identify the 50 widows in need of support. Meals were prepared in accordance with dietary needs and cultural preferences of the beneficiaries alongside educational materials and handouts on anti-social cultural behaviour were prepared for distribution.



## Impact Reached:

Positive feedback was received from the widows, who expressed gratitude for the support and the informative lecture. The event helped raise awareness about the importance of combating anti-social cultural behaviour, with many attendees expressing a commitment to apply the knowledge gained in their daily lives.

The outreach event was a significant success, meeting its objectives of providing feeding support to 50 widows and raising awareness about anti-social cultural behaviour. Pamirian Foundation remains committed to supporting vulnerable community members and promoting social development through similar initiatives.

Year 2021 project was really a success and we extend our heartfelt thanks to all the sponsors, volunteers, and participants who made this project possible. Special appreciation goes to our community stakeholders and to the community leaders for their support in identifying the beneficiaries and creating an enabling environment for the project implementation.



## Programme Outcomes

50 widows received free raw food packs, addressing their immediate food needs.

The event provided a temporary relief from food insecurity, contributing to better health and well-being.

Raised Awareness on Anti-Social Cultural Behaviour.

Attendees gained a better understanding of anti-social cultural behaviours and their negative impacts on individuals and communities.
